

- By Law N° 6800/21, the Council and Municipal Secretary for the Prevention and Treatment of Addictions are created.
- Lack of professionals trained to intervene with Children with Substance Use Disorders.
- The CHILD Training Project is launched.

Training Objectives




- Develop skills and knowledge based on scientific evidence to apply effectively to children whith substance use disorder.

- Achieve qualified training, in accordance with the objectives and requirements of the Institutions.

- Decentralize existing treatment devices.





- Participant evaluations of the Training (Rating of content, relevance of course materials, competency of trainers, and comments on the experience and overall value of the course for each participant.



Evaluation and Monitoring of the implementation of the CHILD Course

- CHILD CARRE TOOL
- The CHILD CARRE measure consists of a semi-structured interview designed to be administered by trained and expert personnel.
- The CHILD CARRE instrument covers seven áreas of interest: physical health, school attendance and social support, drug and alcohol use, legal status, family and social relationships, psychiatric health, and daily activities.
- The first test will be taken before the implementation of CHILD ,then at 3 months and 6 months after the implementation.
- Part of this would be to examine changes in CHILD CARRE scores before and after the intervention.
